Guidelines for talks and posters

Connect with the audience. The C⁴ workshop pulls together expertise from different fields including modern carbon cycling, paleo-climate and earth system evolution. The workshop is meant to favour the cross-pollination among fields that traditionally do not exchange with each other. Thus, the language used for your presentation, either as a talk or poster, is expected to be accessible to a wide research community. We strongly encourage you to start your presentation by introducing the topic for a non-expert in your field. Avoid acronyms where possible and make sure that graphics are accessible.

- Talks: 12 minutes + 3 minutes for questions. Presentation language: English. Please send your presentation ahead of your talk via email (<u>c4workshop@cnr.it</u>) no later than June 19th. If the file is too large to be sent, consider using WeTransfer or similar platforms. For Mac users, we strongly advice to submit your presentation as a pdf if possible.
- **Posters**: each presenter as the chance to give a **2-minute presentation** (i.e., 1 slide, in English) ahead of the poster session (see further details in the final program). Please provide your slide via email (<u>c4workshop@cnr.it</u>) **no later than June 19**th. Poster size: format A0 portrait.
